Subject: Interaction check shows "no interaction" (green) for preparations for which no interaction check could be carried out

Affected product and product versions:

<u>CGM CLINICAL Medication</u> 8.0-2023CW38; 8.0-2023CW20; 8.0-2021CW45; 8.0-2022CW03; 8.0-2022CW18; 8.0-2022 CW27; 9.1-CW44

Dear Sir or Madam,

During our market surveillance, we have become aware of cases in which the following behavior has been observed:

For a medication without a PZN, e.g. a preparation of self-manufactured drug, the interaction check shows a green result (no interaction), which is not correct from a technical point of view, as no interaction check was carried out for this medication, so that it is not known with certainty if an interaction exists or not.

What can happen:

Due to the green color for "no known interactions", the user is led to believe that an interaction check was also carried out on the self-manufactured drug and that no interactions were found, although interactions could possibly occur depending on the active ingredients in the self-manufactured medication.

Measures required:

by the manufacturer CGM Software GmbH

- This Urgent Security Information for affected users
- Hotfix planned for the next days (incl. Information and assistance if necessary)

by the customer

- Distribution of the Urgent Field Safety Notice to all users and their attention to it
- Confirmation of acknowledgement by the signed response form
- Control of the interaction check with a preparation of the company's own production,
 if available
- Update the system as soon as the hotfix is provided by the manufacturer
