KD Medical GmbH Hospital Products is conducting a Field Safety Corrective Action (FSCA) to remove specific LOT numbers of **KD-***LINE*® **Extension-Connection Tubing for connection to infusion and transfusion systems**.

This product removal is limited to the article numbers with the batch numbers (LOT) listed in Table 1. No other batch numbers (LOT) are affected.




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Description of the problem:

Based on customer feedback KD Medical has identified that the stopcock in KD-*LINE*® with batch numbers (LOT) listed in Table 1 might have a minor shrinkage depression in the cavity on the top of the stopcock handle that might lead to insufficient tightness of the stopcock with subsequent fluid leakage – see photo 1 for the potential site of leakage. The defect is normally not visible to the naked eye.





Clinical risk:

The injection molding deviation might compromise the closed infusion/transfusion system which in turn might lead to liquid leakage and/or inadequate administration of fluid or medication, inability to maintain a close system, or contamination of the environment by blood or hazardous drugs.

KD Medical has received two complaints for leakage through the top of the stopcock handle, none of which reported harm.

Actions taken by KD Medical:

KD Medical has identified the root cause and is taking corrective actions to prevent reoccurrence of this issue.



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Actions to be taken by the addressee of this Field Safety Notice:

We kindly ask you to initiate the following activities immediately and with priority!

- 1. Please carefully review this Field Safety Notice in its entirety.
- 2. Distribute this Field Safety Notice to all of your customers on which this action has an impact and ask these customers
 - a. to do not use affected products listed in Table 1 anymore
 - b. it is not necessary to exchange products listed in Table 1, which are currently in use, if you did not experience leakage problems
 - c. to pass this Field Safety Notice on to any organisation where the products listed in Table 1 have been transferred, if applicable
 - d. to identify and quarantine any stocks of the products listed in Table 1 and
 - e. to send back these quarantined stocks to KD Medical Polska sp.z.o.o by 30.04.2024

This Field Safety Notice needs to be passed on to all those who need to be aware within your organisation and to any organisation where the products listed in Table 1 have been transferred.

Please maintain awareness on this notice and resulting action for an appropriate period to ensure effectiveness of the corrective action.
