

## Urgent safety information regarding possible unintentional radiation release due to defective hand switches on mobile X-ray devices

## Dear customers,

Ziehm Imaging GmbH specializes in the development, production and worldwide marketing of mobile X-ray devices. The safety of patients and users during everyday use of our products is our top priority.

With this safety information, we would like to inform you about a measure that we are introducing for our products.

Addressees:	This document is intended for physicians, medical professionals, sales partners and users of the abovementioned mobile X-ray systems.
	It contains important information that will enable you to continue to use your mobile X-ray unit safely and correctly.
Scope:	Ziehm hand switch #88036 Version 1.02 for the device type Ziehm 8000 Ziehm Solo, Ziehm Solo FD Ziehm Vision, Ziehm Vision FD Ziehm Vision R, Ziehm Vision RFD, Ziehm Vision RFD 3D
Problem description:	Mechanical stress such as shocks (e.g. dropping) or impacts can irreversible damage the switching element in the hand switch. A defective switching element may then potentially initiate unintended radiation of the connected mobile X-ray unit.
Preventive measures:	Do not use the affected hand switches.
	Do not connect the affected hand switches to a device.
	Instead, use alternative operating options for initiating radiation, such as foot switches or radiation buttons on the control panel (optional).



In case you are using a device with an analog image intensifier for radiography, this function is not available since it depends on the hand switch until the hand switch is replaced by a compliant component.
Our service or service representative will contact you as soon as possible and arrange for the hand switch to be replaced.
Please ensure in your organization that all users of the above-mentioned products and other persons who need to be informed are made aware of this urgent safety information.
